PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Glasses:	Consider chemical goggles.
Gloves:	1.PE/EVAL/PE 2.TEFLON 3.VITON
Respirator:	Type AX-P Filter of sufficient capacity. (AS/NZS 1716 & 1715, EN 143:2000 & 149:2001, ANSI Z88 or national equivalent)
Storage and Transportation:	Store in cool, dry, protected area. Keep out of reach of children. Keep container in a well ventilated place. Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. Keep away from heat. Keep away from sources of ignition. No smoking. Handle and open container with care.
Fire/Explosion Hazard:	HIGHLY FLAMMABLE. Toxic smoke/fumes in a fire. Risk of explosion if heated under confinement. In case of fire and/or explosion, DO NOT BREATHE FUMES.

EMERGENCY

FIRST AID	
Swallowed:	Give water (if conscious). URGENT MEDICAL ATTENTION. Do NOT give milk or oil.
Eye:	Wash with running water (minimum 15 mins). Medical attention.
Skin:	Wash with soap & water. Apply cleansing cream.
Fire Fighting:	Keep containers cool. Foam.
Spills and Disposal:	Eliminate ignition sources. Absorb with dry agent. Stop leak if safe to do so. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. To clean the floor and all objects contaminated by this material, use water and detergent.
