PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Appropriate engineering controls:	Local Exhaust Ventilation recommended.
Glasses:	Consider chemical goggles.
Gloves:	When handling larger quantities: Neoprene.
Respirator:	Type A Filter of sufficient capacity. (AS/NZS 1716 & 1715, EN 143:2000 & 149:2001, ANSI Z88 or national equivalent)
Storage and Transportation:	Store in cool, dry, protected area. Keep out of reach of children. Keep container in a well ventilated place. Keep away from heat. Keep away from sources of ignition. No smoking.
Fire/Explosion Hazard:	HIGHLY FLAMMABLE. Toxic smoke/fumes in a fire. Risk of explosion if heated under confinement. In case of fire and/or explosion, DO NOT BREATHE FUMES.

EMERGENCY

FIRST AID	
<b>Swallowed:</b>	Give water (if conscious). URGENT MEDICAL ATTENTION. Do NOT give milk or oil. Do NOT give alcohol.
<b>Eye:</b>	Wash with running water (minimum 15 mins). Medical attention.
<b>Skin:</b>	Wash with soap & water. Apply cleansing cream.
<b>Advice To Doctor:</b>	Evaluate for respiratory distress. Consider lavage with cuffed tube. NO adrenalin.
<b>Fire Fighting:</b>	Keep containers cool. Foam.
<b>Spills and Disposal:</b>	Spilled liquid has low boiling temperature and evaporates quickly. Eliminate ignition sources. Control vapour with water spray/ fog. Absorb with dry agent. Stop leak if safe to do so. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. To clean the floor and all objects contaminated by this material, use water and detergent.
