### PRECAUTIONS FOR USE



Appropriate engineering controls:	Local Exhaust Ventilation recommended.
Glasses:	Consider chemical goggles.
Gloves:	1.TEFLON
Respirator:	Type A-P Filter of sufficient capacity. (AS/NZS 1716 & 1715, EN 143:2000 & 149:2001, ANSI Z88 or national equivalent)
Storage and Transportation:	Store in cool, dry, protected area. Keep out of reach of children. Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs.
Fire/Explosion Hazard:	Vapours/gas heavier than air. Toxic smoke/fumes in a fire.
Environment:	May cause long-term adverse effects in the aquatic environment.

Liquid. Does not mix with water. Floats on water. Combustible.

### FIRST AID

<b>Swallowed:</b>	Give water (if conscious). Seek medical advice. Do NOT give milk or oil. Do NOT give alcohol.
<b>Eye:</b>	Wash with running water.
<b>Skin:</b>	Remove contaminated clothing. Wash with soap & water.
<b>Inhaled:</b>	Fresh air. Rest, keep warm. If breath shallow, give oxygen. Medical attention.
<b>Fire Fighting:</b>	Foam.
<b>Spills and Disposal:</b>	Eliminate ignition sources. Absorb with dry agent. Stop leak if safe to do so. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. To clean the floor and all objects contaminated by this material, use water and detergent.
