Appropriate engineering controls:	General Exhaust Ventilation adequate.

Gloves:	1.BUTYL 2.NEOPRENE 3.HYPALON
Respirator:	Type K Filter of sufficient capacity. (AS/NZS 1716 & 1715, EN 143:2000 & 149:2001, ANSI Z88 or national equivalent)
Storage and Transportation:	Store in cool, dry, protected area. Keep out of reach of children.
Fire/Explosion Hazard:	Toxic smoke/fumes in a fire.
Environment:	Harmful to aquatic organisms.

FIRST AID
