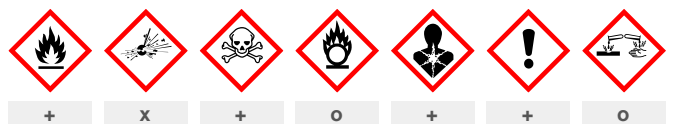
Swallowed:	Give water (if conscious). Seek medical advice. Do NOT give milk or oil. Do NOT give alcohol.
